## STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS NO. 20 OF 2011

THE MINISTER IN EXERCISE OF THE POWER CONFERRED ON HER BY SECTION 3 (4) OF THE FOREIGN NATIONALS AND COMMONWEALTH CITIZENS (EMPLOYMENT) ACT, CAP. 115 MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER—

**1. Citation.** This Order may be cited as the

## <u>FOREIGN NATIONALS AND COMMONWEALTH CITIZENS</u> (EMPLOYMENT) (WORK PERMIT AMNESTY) ORDER, 2011.

- 2. **Definition.** In this Order-
  - "Act" means the Foreign Nationals and Commonwealth Citizens (Employment) Act Cap. 115.
- **3. Granting of Work Permit Amnesty.** An amnesty is hereby granted to persons working in Grenada without the requisite work permit, pursuant to the Act, under the following conditions—
  - (a) a work permit granted under the amnesty shall be subject to the provisions of the Act; and
  - (b) a work permit may be granted under the amnesty to an employer who, upon making an application, provides the following information—
    - (i) the legal entry of his employee into Grenada; and
    - (ii) the time period in which the employee has been working for the employer.

**4. Commencement.** This Order shall come into effect from the 11th of June, 2011 and shall end on the 31st of August, 2011.
