A PROCLAMATION



## CARLYLE ARNOLD GLEAN Governor-General.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 7 of the Bank Holidays Act Cap. 25, that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General from time to time by Proclamation in the *Gazette* to appoint a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout Grenada;

NOW THEREFORE, I CARLYLE ARNOLD GLEAN, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General in and over Grenada, do appoint Tuesday, 7th August, 2012 from 1:00 p.m. to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout Grenada;

GIVEN under my hand and the Public Seal of Grenada, this 7th day of August Two Thousand and Twelve in the sixtieth year of the reign of HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH THE SECOND.
