A PROCLAMATION



WHEREAS under the Bank Holidays Act (Cap. 25) as amended the second Monday in August and from noon the day following are declared to be Bank Holidays, to be known as Carnival August Celebrations;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the morning of Tuesday 9th August should also be part of the Carnival Celebrations in the year 2011;

AND WHEREAS by Section 7 of the Act as amended I am empowered to appoint a special day or part of a day to be observed as a Bank Holiday;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Carlyle A. Glean, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General of Grenada, hereby appoint the morning of Tuesday the 9th August, 2011, to 12 noon to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout Grenada:

and eleven in the sixtieth year of the reign of HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH THE SECOND.
