A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 52 of the Constitution of Grenada that the Governor-General may at any time prorogue or dissolve Parliament;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that Parliament be prorogued from the 17th day of September, 2012;

NOW THEREFORE, I Sir Carlyle Arnold Glean, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General in and over Grenada, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, do hereby prorogue the Parliament of Grenada from the 17th day of September, 2012, until such further date as may be appointed.

AND MEMBERS of the said Parliament and all other of Her Majesty's officers and loving subjects in Grenada, and all other whom it may concern, are hereby required to take due notice hereof and give their ready obedience accordingly.

GIVEN under my hand and the Public Seal of Grenada this 17 th day of September, Two Thousand and Twelve in the sixtieth year of the reign of HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH THE SECOND.
