1. Citation. This Order may be cited as the

SUPREME COURT (SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE OF JUDGES) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2012

and shall be read as one with the Supreme Court (Salaries, Allowances and Conditions of Service of Judges) Order, CAP. 336 Subsidiary Legislation of the 2010 Continuous Revised Edition of the Laws of Grenada hereinafter referred to as the "principal Order".

- **2.** Commencement. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of July, 2007.
- **3. Repeal of section 3.** The principal Order is amended by repealing section 3 and substituting the following section:—
 - "3. The Third Schedule to the West Indies Associated States Supreme Court Order is hereby repealed and substituted with the following Schedule:—
