1. Citation. This Order may be cited as the

SUPREME COURT (MASTERS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2012

and shall be read as one with the Supreme Court (Masters) Order (SRO 2 of 2001), CAP. 336 Subsidiary Legislation of the 2010 Continuous Revised Edition of the Laws of Grenada hereinafter referred to as the “principal Order”.

2. Commencement. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of July, 2010.

3. Amendment of section 5 of principal Order. The principal Order is amended by repealing section 5 and substituting the following section:—

“5. There shall be three Masters”.
