STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS NO. 29 OF 2021

THE MINISTER IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED ON HIM PURSUANT TO SECTION 3B (5) OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, CAP. 289A HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER—

1. Citation. This Order may be cited as the

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC WARDEN UNIFORM) (AMENDMENT)
ORDER, 2021.

2. Definition. In this Order—

“principal Act” means the Road Traffic Act, Chapter 289A.

3. Amendment to section 3B of the Act. Section 3B of the principal Act is amended by repealing subsection (3) and substituting therefor the following new subsection—

“(3) The uniform to be worn by a traffic warden in execution of his or her duty shall be—

- (a) blue baseball cap with the words “Traffic Warden” on the front;
- (b) white shirt with epaulets, whether with short sleeves or long sleeves;
- (c) black trousers or black skirt with one white vertical stripe down each side of the trousers or skirt;
- (d) standard black belt or black utility equipment belt;
- (e) black socks devoid of patterns to be worn above the ankles when wearing trousers or worn at knee height when wearing skirts;
- (f) black shoes;

- (g) blue reflective bib with silver reflective vertical and horizontal stripes on the front and rear and with patches with—
 - (i) the words “Grenada Transport Commission” on the right breast pocket; and
 - (ii) the words “Traffic Warden” at the rear; and
- (h) standard dark blue rain gear with the words “Traffic Warden” at the rear.”.
