STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS NO. 31 OF 2011

THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED ON HIM BY SECTION 28 OF THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ACT, NO. 35 OF 1993 MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER—

(Gazetted 11th November, 2011).

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (5) of section 28 of the Representation of the People Act No. 35 of 1993 (“the Act”) that when it appears to the Governor General that the enumeration list cannot be completed within the enumeration period, he may by Order, extend the period to such further period as he considers necessary;

WHEREAS an enumeration period was pending in 2009;

WHEREAS the enumeration could not be completed in 2009 and the Governor General extended the enumeration period under Statutory Rules and Orders No. 27 of 2009;

WHEREAS such enumeration could not be completed within the time period stipulated in 2010;

AND WHEREAS the Governor General by virtue of his powers under section 28 of the Act now seeks to extend the enumeration period;

NOW THEREFORE be it declared that the Governor General makes the following Order:

**1. Citation.** This Order may be cited as the

REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE (ENUMERATION  
EXTENSION PERIOD) ORDER, 2011.

**2. Extension of Enumeration Period.** It is hereby ordered that the enumeration period for the enumeration year 2009, shall be further
