A PROCLAMATION



CARLYLE ARNOLD GLEAN Governor-General.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 7 of the Bank Holidays Act (Cap. 25), that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General from time to time by Proclamation in the *Gazette* to appoint a special day or part thereof to be observed as a Bank holiday throughout Grenada;

NOW THEREFORE, I CARLYLE ARNOLD GLEAN, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General in and over Grenada, do appoint Monday, 20th February, 2012, and Tuesday, 21st February, 2012, to be observed as Bank Holidays throughout Carriacou and Petite Martinique;

GIVEN under my hand and the Public Seal of Grenada, this 15th day of February Two Thousand and Twelve in the sixtieth year of the reign of HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH THE SECOND.
