STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS NO. 8 OF 2020

THE MINISTER OF TRADE, INDUSTRY, CO-OPERATIVES AND CARICOM AFFAIRS ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE GRENADA BUREAU OF STANDARDS, UNDER SECTION 18 (1) OF THE STANDARDS ACT CAP. 310 HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER—

(Gazetted 13th March, 2020).

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the

COMPULSORY STANDARDS ORDER, 2020.

2. Repeal of Compulsory Standards (No. 2) Order, 2006. The Compulsory Standards (No. 2) Order, 2006, SRO No. 29 of 2006 is hereby repealed and replaced.

3. Declaration of Compulsory Standard. The following standard is declared a compulsory standard—

GDS 6: 2019 – Specification for Hollow Concrete Blocks.

4. Purpose of Standard. The purpose for which the standard is intended is to ensure that hollow concrete blocks meet the required strength to prevent collapse of structures and buildings and to ensure safety of human lives.

5. Commencement. This Order shall come into force on the 31st day of March, 2020.
