STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS NO. 9 OF 2020

THE MINISTER OF TRADE, INDUSTRY, CO-OPERATIVES AND CARICOM AFFAIRS ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE GRENADA BUREAU OF STANDARDS, UNDER SECTION 18 (1) OF THE STANDARDS ACT CAP. 310 HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER—

(Gazetted 13th March, 2020).

**1. Short title.** This Order may be cited as the

COMPULSORY STANDARDS (NO. 2) ORDER, 2020.

**2. Repeal of Compulsory Standards (Pneumatic Passenger Car Tyres) Order, 1999.** The Compulsory Standards (Pneumatic Passenger Car Tyres) Order, 1999, SRO No. 23 of 1999 is hereby repealed and replaced.

**3. Declaration of Compulsory Standard.** The following standard is declared a compulsory standard—

GDS 26: 2019 – Specification for Pneumatic Passenger Tyres.

**4. Purpose of Standard.** The purpose for which the standard is intended is to protect human health and safety of the environment.

**5. Commencement.** This Order shall come into force on the 31st day of March, 2020.
