AN ACT to appropriate a sum not exceeding one billion, one hundred and thirty-four million, thirteen thousand, nine hundred and fifty-six dollars (\$1,134,013,956.00) to the service of the State of Grenada for the period January 1st to December 31st, 2019.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives, and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the

APPROPRIATION (2019) ACT, 2018.

2.—(1) There may be issued from the Consolidated Fund and applied to the service of the State of Grenada

Appropriation.

for the period January 1st to December 31st 2019, a sum not exceeding one billion, one hundred and thirty-four million, thirteen thousand, nine hundred and fifty-six dollars (\$1,134,013,956.00).

(2) The sum mentioned in subsection (1) is appropriated for the purposes specified in the Schedule.
