AN ACT to amend the National Insurance Act CAP. 205.

*[29th December, 2017].*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives and by the authority of the same as follows—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the

Short title.

**NATIONAL INSURANCE (AMENDMENT)**  
**ACT, 2017.**

and shall be read as one with the National Insurance Act, Chapter 205, hereinafter referred to as the “principal Act”.

**2.** Section 36 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (2A) the following new subsection—

Amendment to section 36 of principal Act.

“(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of this section and subject to subsection (4), nothing contained therein shall prevent the payment of sickness benefits directly to an employer of an insured person, provided that written instructions have been received from the insured person.

(4) For the purposes of subsection (3), the payment of sickness benefits paid to the employer shall not exceed the sum paid by the employer to the insured person in respect of the sickness benefits.”.
