BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the
House of Representatives of Grenada, and by the authority of
the same as follows—

1. —(1) This Act may be cited as the

ACT, 2016and shall be read as one with the Customs (Service Charge)
Act, Chapter 75D hereinafter referred to as the “principal
Act”.(2) This Act shall come into force on such a day as the
Minister of Finance may appoint by Order in the *Gazette*.

section 4 of
principal Act.

2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (1) the following new subsection—

“(1A) In the case of raw materials imported by a person engaged in manufacturing for the purposes of the Investment Act, 2014 and any regulations made thereunder, the customs service charge shall be payable to the Comptroller and, subject to section 6, shall be the equivalent of three per cent of the CIF value of the raw materials imported into the State under any Customs law whether or not the goods are subject to Customs duties.”

3. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by repealing paragraph (b).

Transitional
provisions.

4. Upon commencement of this Act, every subsisting varied rate of customs service charge granted pursuant to paragraph (b) of section 6 of the principal Act shall remain in effect for six months or until the varied rate was set to expire, whichever first occurs.
