AN ACT to provide for the payment and collection of fees
and for related matters.

[16th May, 2014].

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent
Majesty, by and with the advice and consent
of the Senate and the House of Representatives of
Grenada, and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the—

Short title.

GOVERNMENT FEES ACT, 2014.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

Interpretation.

“function” in relation to a public body includes
the consideration of any application, any
examination and/or inspection, the grant of
any right, sanction, permit, licence, certificate

or other document of a similar nature, by that public body in accordance with any power or duty under any provision of law, regulation or administrative direction.

“public body” means

- (a) the Government, and any department, institution or undertaking thereof;
- (b) any local authority;
- (c) any authority, board, commission, committee or other similar body, whether permanent or temporary, for remuneration or otherwise, providing a public function.

Minister of Finance may make fees regulations.

3.—(1) The Minister of Finance may make regulations providing for the payment of fees in relation to the performance of any function by a public body and for the payment of fees for any matters incidental to the performance of any such function.

(2) Regulations made under sub-section (1) may provide for the time and manner of the payment of fees and for all matters incidental to their due collection and accounting.

(3) Regulations made pursuant to this Act shall be subject to negative resolution of the House of Representatives.

General powers under this Act additional to specific powers.

4. The powers conferred by this Act shall be in addition to any specific or general power conferred on any public body under any other provision of law and any such power shall be construed as being without prejudice to the powers provided for under this Act.

Fees etc. prescribed by written law.

5. Nothing in this Act shall be held to affect the amount of any fees or payments chargeable under any written law in force when express provision is made for the amount of such fees or payments under that written law.

6. All sums received by a public body shall be accounted for in the manner prescribed by regulation and shall be paid into the Consolidated Fund. Consolidated Fund.
