AN ACT to amend the Patents Act, No. 16 of 2011.

[18th May, 2012].

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives, and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the—

Short title.

PATENTS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2012.

2. In this Act—

Interpretation.

“principal Act” means the Patents Act, No. 16 of 2011.
