AN ACT to amend the Customs Act No. 9 of 2015.

[15th July, 2016].

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives and by the authority of the same as follows—

1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the—

Short title.

CUSTOMS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2016.

and shall be read as one with the Customs Act No. 9 of 2015 hereinafter referred to as the “principal Act”.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of July, 2015.

2. Section 267 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (2) as follows—

Amendment to section 267 of principal Act.

-
- (a) in paragraph (c) by removing the “full-stop” at the end of the paragraph and substituting it with a “semi-colon”; and
- (b) by inserting after paragraph (c) the following new paragraph—
- “(d) the repeal shall not, affect—
- (i) any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued, or incurred under the repealed law; or
 - (ii) any penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred in respect of any offence committed against any written law so repealed; or
 - (iii) any investigation, legal proceedings or remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment as aforesaid,

and any such investigation, legal proceedings or remedy may be instituted, continued or enforced, and any such penalty, forfeiture or punishment may be imposed, as if the repealing written law had not been made.”.
