AN ACT to amend the Road Traffic Act, CAP. 289A.

[3rd July, 2015].

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Grenada, and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the—

Short title.

ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2015

2. Section 54 of the Road Traffic Act CAP. 289 is amended by repealing sub-sections (4) and (5) and substituting therefor the following—

Amendment of section 54.

“(4) The holder of a valid driving licence issued in any of the other member states of the Caribbean Community and Common Market (CARICOM) and valid for a period of not less than six months from

the date of entry into Grenada shall be deemed to be the holder of a licence to drive in Grenada, for the ensuing six month period.

(5) A person to whom sub-section (4) applies shall only be entitled to drive in Grenada a motor vehicle of the class or classes for which he or she holds an authorization to drive in the other CARICOM member state in which his or her driving licence was issued.

(6) In the event that a person referred to in sub-section (4), is desirous of driving in Grenada beyond the six month period referred to in sub-section (4), he or she shall make the necessary application in accordance with the requirements of this Act and upon payment of the prescribed fee may be granted a permit to drive for the period specified therein.

(7) The holder of a driving licence issued in an OECS member state shall, while such licence remains valid, be deemed to be the holder of a licence to drive in Grenada.

(8) A person to whom sub-section (7) applies shall only be entitled to drive in Grenada a motor vehicle of the class or classes for which he or she holds an authorization to drive in the other OECS member state in which his or her driving licence was issued.

(9) For the purposes of sub-section (7) and (8) the expression "OECS" means the Organisation of the Eastern Caribbean States established under the Treaty of Basseterre 1981 and continued under Article 2 of the Treaty of Basseterre Establishing the

Organisation of Eastern Caribbean States Economic Union 2010.

(10) The Licensing Authority shall keep a register of all holders in the State who hold valid international driving licences issued elsewhere and of all holders of international driving licences and temporary licences issued by Authority.”
