AN ACT to amend the Property Tax Act, No. 2 of 1997.

[18th May, 2012].

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the—

Short title.

PROPERTY TAX (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2012.

2. In this Act—

Interpretation.

“principal Act” means the Property Tax Act, No. 2 of 1997.

Amendment of
section 36 of the
principal Act.

3. Sub-section 1 of section 36 of the principal Act is hereby repealed and substituted with the following section:

“36 (1) A taxpayer may at all reasonable times on payment of such fee as may be prescribed, inspect and take copies or any extracts from any Property Tax Register, whether current or closed, any draft valuation list or valuation list which is still available or any other services relating to the valuation of property provided pursuant to this Act.”
