AN ACT to amend the Licences Act Cap. 172.

*[30th May, 2014].*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Grenada, and by the Authority of the same as follows—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the

Short title.

LICENCES (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2014.

**2.** In this Act—

Interpretation.

“principal Act” means the Licences Act, Cap. 172.

**3.** The principal Act is amended by deleting the words “Permanent Secretary” wherever it appears throughout the Act and substituting with the words “Comptroller of Inland Revenue”.

General amendment.

Amendment  
of section 4 of  
principal Act.

**4.** Section 4(4) of the principal Act is deleted and substituted as follows—

“(4) (a) A person who is liable to follow a trade, profession or calling under this Act, shall pay a yearly licence as prescribed in Part II of the First Schedule.

(b) The licence shall expire on the thirty-first day of December in each year.

(c) In all cases the full licence fee shall be paid annually except in circumstances where a person becomes qualified to follow a trade, profession, business or calling after the 1st day of July of that year. That person shall be liable to pay only one-half the full licence fee.

Amendment  
of section 8 of  
principal Act.

**5.** Section 8 of the principal Act is hereby repealed and substituted as follows—

“8. A person liable to take out a licence under this Act shall apply to the Comptroller of Inland Revenue—

- (a) within the first seven days of the month of January, in the case of a yearly licence; or
- (b) within seven days of the day upon which he or she first becomes liable to take a licence.”

Amendment of  
section 11 of  
principal Act.

**6.** Section 11 of the principal Act is repealed and substituted with the following—

“11. A person liable to take out a licence under this Act and refuses to do so, commits an offence

and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding thirty thousand dollars.”
