AN ACT to amend the Terrorism Act No. 16 of 2012.

[9th January, 2015].

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Grenada, and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the Short title.

TERRORISM (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2015.

2. In this Act— Interpretation.

“principal Act” means the Terrorism Act No. 16 of 2012.

3. Section 14AB of the principal Act is amended in paragraph (b) by inserting the words “any part of” after the word “releasing” where it appears.

Amendment of
section 14B of

4. Section 14B of the principal Act is amended by repealing sub-section (4) and substituting therefor the following—

“(4) (1) An Order made under sub-section (3) may make such provision for the payment of the basic and necessary expenses of a designated entity, including—

- (a) any payment for food stuffs, rent or mortgage, medicines and medical treatment, taxes, insurance premiums and public utility charges;
- (b) any reasonable professional fees and reimbursement of expenses associated with the provision of legal services;
- (c) any fees or service charge incurred for the routine holding or maintenance of frozen funds or other financial assets or economic resources; or
- (d) any extraordinary expenses.

(2) In making provisions for the basic and necessary expenses of a designated entity under sub-section (1) the court must be satisfied that—

- (a) the United Nations Sanctions Committee received notification of the application of the designated entity; and

- (b) a request was made by the Financial Intelligence Unit to the United Nations Sanctions Committee for its recommendations on the application of the designated entity.

(3) The Court may—

- (a) within seven days of the notification referred to in sub-section 2; and
- (b) in the absence of a negative decision by the United Nations Sanctions Committee within forty-eight hours of such notification,

order the release of funds from the frozen account as it may consider reasonable to cover the basic and necessary expenses of a designated entity.

(4) Where an application by a designated entity is for the release of funds to cover the extraordinary expenses of a designated entity, the court must not grant an authorisation for the release of any funds unless prior written approval of the United Nations Sanctions Committee is obtained.”

5. Section 19 of the principal Act is amended by deleting sub-section (3a) and substituting therefor the following— Amendment of section 19 of the principal Act.

“(3a) A person commits an offence if he—

- (a) provides or collects property for or on behalf of an individual terrorist or terrorist organisation; and intends that

the property be used, or there is reasonable cause to suspect that the property may be used, for the purposes of terrorism; or

- (b) collects, provides or attempts to collect or provide or make available any property whether directly or indirectly to any terrorist organisation or any person who is concerned with or connected to the financing of terrorism; or
- (c) collects or provides any property for or on behalf of an individual terrorist.”

Amendment of section 27A of the principal Act.

6. Section 27A of the principal Act is amended in sub-paragraph (b) (i) of sub-section (1) by deleting the words “3 or 4” and substituting therefor the figure “22A”.

Amendment to Schedule in principal Act.

7. Part 1A of the Schedule headed “Treaties” is amended by deleting the word “Nangam” and substituting therefor the word “Navigation”.
