*Governor-General.*AN ACT to amend the Integrity in Public Life Act No. 24
of 2013.*[9th January, 2015].*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the

Short title.

INTEGRITY IN PUBLIC LIFE (AMENDMENT) ACT,
2015.

and shall be read as one with the Integrity in Public Life Act No. 24 of 2013, hereinafter referred to as the “principal Act.”

2. The principal Act is amended by inserting after section 23, the following section—

“Furnishing financial statements to the Director of Audit.

23A. The Commission shall not later than four months after each financial year, furnish a copy of the financial statements and the annual report to the Director of Audit who shall audit the financial statements in accordance with the Audit Act Cap. 22A.”

Amendment of section 24 of principal Act.

3. Section 24(1) of the principal Act is hereby repealed and substituted with the following—

“Audit.

24.—(1) The Director of Audit may appoint an Auditor in accordance with section 9(1)(a), of the Audit Act to conduct the audit of the Commission.”

Amendment of section 25 of principle Act.

4. Section 25 of the principal Act is hereby repealed and substituted with the following—

“Report of Auditor.

25. The Director of Audit or an Auditor appointed pursuant to Section 24 shall as soon as practicable and not later than three months after the receipt of the financial statements and annual report from the Commission, audit the financial statements in accordance with the Audit Act CAP. 22A.”

Amendment of section 26 of principal Act.

5. Section 26(1) of the principal Act is hereby repealed and substituted with the following—

“26.—(1) Without delay after the completion of his or her Audit of the Commission, the Director of Audit shall submit—

(a) a copy of his or her report to the Commission; and

(b) a copy of the report referred to in paragraph (a) together with the financial statements and the Annual Report to the Minister, and the Minister of Finance.

(2) The Minister shall after receiving the audit report, together with the financial statement and the annual report lay same before the House of Representatives in accordance with section 82(4) of the Constitution and section 18(6) of the Audit Act.

(3) As soon as reasonably practicable after the report, together with the financial statements and the annual report of the Commission have been laid before the House of Representatives, the Commission shall cause the report, financial statements and a summary of its annual report to be published in the *Gazette*, and a copy of the annual report shall be made available to any person on payment of the prescribed fee to the Commission.”

6. Section 28 (5) of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words “sub-section (3)” and substituting the words “sub-section (4).”
