AN ACT to amend the Immigration Act to secure the freedom of movement of citizens of OECS Member States that are parties to the Protocol of Eastern Caribbean Economic Union by granting a stay of indefinite duration, and for incidental and connected matters.

[3rd February, 2012].

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the

Short title.

IMMIGRATION (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2012.

2. In this Act—

Interpretation.

“principal Act” means the Immigration Act, Cap. 145 of the 1990 Revised Laws of Grenada.

Amendment of

3. The principal Act is amended in section 2 by inserting after the definition of “alien” the following definitions—

“citizen of a Protocol Member State” means a person who is a citizen of a Member State of the Organisation of Eastern Caribbean States that is a party to the Protocol of the Eastern Caribbean Economic Union.

4. The principal Act is amended by inserting after section 4 the following new section—

4A.— (1) Subject to section 4, an immigration officer shall grant a permit for a citizen of a Protocol Member State to enter and remain in Grenada for a stay of indefinite duration.

(2) The right to enter and remain in Grenada under subsection (1) may be revoked if a person is deemed to be a prohibited alien in accordance with the procedures for due process set out in this Act.
