**CHAPTER 78**  
**DECEASED OFFICER'S SALARY OR PENSION ACT**

**An Act to authorise the payment otherwise than to executors or administrators of small sums of money due to deceased persons on account of salary or pension payable from public funds.**

**1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the Deceased Officer's Salary or Pension Act.

**2. Payment of salary or pension due to deceased may be paid to person entitled thereto without letters of administration**

On the death of a person to whom any sum or sums of money not exceeding in all seven thousand five hundred dollars may then be due on account of salary or pension chargeable on the Consolidated Fund, it shall be lawful for the Minister of Finance by warrant under his or her hand, on his or her being satisfied of the expediency of dispensing with letters testamentary or letters of administration, to cause the sum or sums to be paid to such person or persons as the Minister may consider to be entitled thereto, without requiring the production of letters testamentary or letters of administration.

**3. Validity of payments under this Act**

A payment made in pursuance of this Act shall be valid against all persons; and all persons acting under its provisions shall be absolutely discharged from all liability in respect of all monies duly paid by them under this Act.
