A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS under the Bank Holidays Act (Cap. 25) as amended the second Monday in August and from noon the day following are declared as Bank Holidays, to be known as Carnival August Celebrations;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the morning of Tuesday 13th August should also be part of the Carnival celebrations in the year 2013;

AND WHEREAS by Section 7 of the Act as amended I am empowered to appoint a special day or part of a day to be observed as a Bank Holiday;

NOW THEREFORE, I CECILE LA GRENADE, Dame Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General in and over Grenada, hereby appoint the morning of Tuesday the 13th day of August, 2013, to 12 noon to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout Grenada.
