## STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS NO. 11 OF 2018

THE MINISTER IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED ON HIM BY SECTION 9(2) (b) OF THE CITIZENSHIP ACT, CHAPTER 54, HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER—

(Gazetted 4th April, 2018).

WHEREAS it is provided by section 9(1) of the Citizenship Act that a citizen by registration or naturalisation shall cease to be a citizen if he or she is deprived of that citizenship by an Order of the Minister;

AND WHEREAS it is further provided by Section 9(2) (b) of the said Act that the Minister may by Order deprive a citizen of his citizenship if he is satisfied that it is in the interest of national security to do so;

AND WHEREAS the Minister is satisfied that Muhammad Ehsan should be deprived of his citizenship in the interest of national security;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED as follows:

1. Citation. This Order may be cited as the

## CITIZENSHIP (DEPRIVATION) (MUHAMMAD EHSAN) ORDER, 2018.

**2. Deprivation of Citizenship.** Muhammad Ehsan, a person registered as a citizen of Grenada, is, under and by virtue of Section 9(2) (b) of the Citizenship Act, Chapter 54, hereby deprived of citizenship in the interest of national security.
