A PROCLAMATION



CÉCILE E. F. LA GRENADE

Governor-General.

WHEREAS by Proclamation dated the 29th day of January, 2018, issued under subsection (1) of section 52 of the Constitution of Grenada, Parliament was dissolved on the 29th day of January, 2018;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 51 of the Constitution of Grenada that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Grenada and shall commence at such time as the Governor-General may by Proclamation appoint;

AND WHEREAS it is further provided by subsection (2) of section 51 of the Constitution of Grenada that there shall be a session of Parliament once at least in every year, so that a period of six months shall not intervene between the last sitting of Parliament in one session and the first sitting in the next session;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CÉCILE LA GRENADE, Dame Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General in and over Grenada do hereby appoint the Trade Centre at Morne Rouge, in the parish of Saint George as the place where the First Session of the Tenth Parliament shall be held at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon on Friday the 27th day of April, 2018, as the time at which the said session shall begin;

AND MEMBERS of the said Parliament and all other Her Majesty's Officers and loving subjects in Grenada, and all others whom it may concern, are hereby required to take due notice hereof and give their ready obedience accordingly.

GIVEN under my hand and the Public Seal of Grenada this 19th day of April, Two Thousand and Eighteen in the sixty-fifth year of the reign of HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH THE SECOND.
