A PROCLAMATION



CÉCILE E. F. LA GRENADE

Governor-General.

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 51 of the Constitution of Grenada that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Grenada as the Governor-General may by Proclamation appoint;

AND WHEREAS historically the Parliament Chamber at York House in the Town of Saint George was appointed as the place where each session of Parliament was to be held;

AND WHEREAS due to the passage of Hurricane Ivan through Grenada on the 7th day of September, Two Thousand and Four, the Parliament Chamber at York House was rendered unsuitable for the continuation of the First Session of the Seventh Parliament;

AND WHEREAS by Proclamation dated the 28th day of October Two Thousand and Four, the Bell Lecture Hall on the campus of the St. George's University situate at True Blue in the parish of Saint George was duly appointed as the place where the First Session of the Seventh Parliament would be from thenceforth held;

AND WHEREAS by Proclamation dated the 2nd day of March, Two Thousand and Five, the Trade Center situate at Morne Rouge in the parish of Saint George was duly appointed as the place where the Second Session of the Seventh Parliament was to

be held and was duly appointed as such for each subsequent session of Parliament;

AND WHEREAS by Proclamation dated the 19th day of April, Two Thousand and Eighteen, the Trade Center was duly appointed as the place where the First Session of the Tenth Parliament shall be held;

AND WHEREAS the Parliament Building at Mount Wheldale in the Town of Saint George was constructed during the period of Two Thousand and Thirteen and Two Thousand and Eighteen and is now suitable as a place for sessions of Parliament to be held;

NOW THEREFORE, I CÉCILE LA GRENADE, Dame Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General in and over Grenada do hereby appoint the Parliament Building at Mount Wheldale in the Town of Saint George as the place where the First Session of the Tenth Parliament shall from the 21st day of June, Two Thousand and Eighteen thenceforth be held;

AND MEMBERS of the said Parliament and all other Her Majesty's Officers and loving subjects in Grenada, and all others whom it may concern, are hereby required to take due notice hereof and give their ready obedience accordingly.

GIVEN under my hand and the Public Seal of Grenada this 12th day of June, Two Thousand and Eighteen in the sixty-sixth year of the reign of HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH THE SECOND.
