STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS NO. 16 OF 2017

THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED ON HER
BY SECTION 52 OF THE MARRIAGE ACT CAP. 184, MAKES THE FOLLOWING
REGULATIONS—

(Gazetted 21st July, 2017).

1. Citation. These Regulations may be cited as the

MARRIAGE (SPECIAL LICENCES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2017,

and shall be read as one with the Marriage (Special Licences) Regulations Cap. 184,
hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”.

2. Repeal of Regulation 2 of principal Regulations. Regulation 2 of the principal
Regulations is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor—

“2. The Governor-General may in accordance with these Regulations grant
a special licence for the marriage of persons in Grenada.”.

3. Repeal of Regulation 4 of principal Regulations. Regulation 4 of the principal
Regulations is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor—

“4. There shall be attached to the application a solemn declaration made
by the applicant before the Registrar-General verifying the facts stated in the
application and that the applicant knows no just cause or impediment why the
intended marriage should not be solemnised.”.
