STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS NO. 18 OF 2013

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 3 OF THE GRENADA PORTS
AUTHORITY ACT CAP. 247, THE MINISTER HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING NOTICE—

1. Citation. This Notice may be cited as the

GRENADA PORTS AUTHORITY (APPOINTMENT OF PORTS)
NOTICE, 2013.

2. Declaration of Port. The place specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a port for the purpose of the Grenada Ports Authority Act, subject to the conditions and limitations set out in the Schedule.

3. Removal of Limitation. This Notice supersedes the Grenada Ports Authority Notice contained in the Government *Gazette* of July 6, 1984, No. 37, by removing the limitation for use only by oil tankers and providing for the Port of Tyrrel Bay to be used by all ships including yachts.

SCHEDULE

CARRIACOU: The Port of Tyrrel Bay comprising within its limits the area of sea within Tyrrel Bay east of an imaginary line drawn on Longitude 61° 31' West.

Ships over 200 GRT are subject to compulsory pilotage in the Port of Tyrrel Bay in accordance with Section 54 of the Ports Authority Act.

Provided that any vessel's master who satisfies the Authority that he has made a minimum of twenty (20) calls to Tyrrel Bay before the date of this Notice may apply to the Authority for an exemption from compulsory pilotage.
