THE MINISTER IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED ON HIM BY SECTION 64 OF THE NATIONAL INSURANCE ACT, CHAPTER 205 HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS—

1. Citation and commencement.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the

NATIONAL INSURANCE (COLLECTION OF CONTRIBUTIONS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2020,

and shall be read as one with the National Insurance (Collection of Contributions) Regulations, Chapter 205 hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations".

- (2) These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 31st day of March, 2020.
- **2. Amendment to regulation 4 of principal Regulations.** Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is amended in subregulation (1) in the chapeau by deleting the words "January 2020" after the words "As of the 1st day of" and substituting therefor the words "April, 2020".
- **3.** Amendment to regulation 7 of principal Regulations. Regulation 7 of the principal Regulations is amended in subregulation (1) by deleting the words "January 2020" after the words "As of the 1st day of" and substituting therefor the words "April, 2020".
- **4. Amendment to Schedule to principal Regulations.** The Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended as follows—
 - (a) in Part I by inserting after the following row-
