

## GRENADA

STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS NO. 22 OF 2013

THE MINISTER IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED ON HIM PURSUANT TO SECTION 36 OF THE REGIONAL SECURITY SYSTEM ACT CAP. 279A OF THE 2010 CONTINUOUS REVISED EDITION OF THE LAWS OF GRENADA, MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER—

(Gazetted 8th November, 2013).

**1. Citation.** This Order may be cited as the

REGIONAL SECURITY SYSTEM ORDER, 2013.

**2. Definition.** In this Order—

“principal Act” means the Regional Security System Act Cap. 279A of the 2010 Continuous Revised Edition of the Laws of Grenada.

**3. Amendment of First Schedule.** The First Schedule to the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by deleting the terms “Central Liaison Office” or “CLO” wherever it appears and substituting therefor in each case, the term “Regional Security System Headquarters”;
- (b) by deleting the terms “Regional Security Coordinator” or “Coordinator” wherever it appears and substituting therefor in each case, the term “Executive Director”.

**4. Amendment of Second Schedule.** The Second Schedule to the principal Act is amended—

- (a) in Article 1 by deleting the definition of the word “Coordinator”, and substituting the following new definition—

““Executive Director” means the Regional Security Executive Director and, during his or her absence or incapacity, the officer authorised to act as Regional Security Executive Director;”

- (b) by deleting the term “Central Liaison Office” or “CLO”. wherever it appears and substituting therefor in each case, the term, “Regional Security System Headquarters”;
- (c) by deleting the terms “Regional Security Coordinator” or “Coordinator” wherever it appears and substituting therefor in each case, the term “Executive Director”.
