A PROCLAMATION



CÉCILE LA GRENADE Governor-General.

WHEREAS under the Bank Holidays Act, Chapter 25 (as amended) the second Monday in August and from noon the day following are declared as Bank Holidays to be known as Carnival August Celebrations;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the morning of Tuesday the 11th day of August should also be part of the Carnival August Celebrations in the year 2015;

AND WHEREAS by Section 7 of the Act I am empowered to appoint a special day or part of a day to be observed as a Bank Holiday;

NOW THEREFORE, I CÉCILE LA GRENADE, Dame Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General in and over Grenada, hereby appoint the morning of Tuesday the 11th day of August, 2015, to 12 noon to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout Grenada.
