STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS NO. 34 OF 2019

THE MINISTER IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED ON HIM BY SECTIONS 62B AND 122 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT CAP. 289A HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS—

(Gazetted 16th December, 2019).

1. Citation. These Regulations may be cited as the—

ROAD TRAFFIC (BREATH TEST FOR ALCOHOL) REGULATIONS, 2019.

2. Definitions.—(1) In these Regulations—

“positive reading” means a result exceeding the prescribed limit in accordance with section 62 of the Act;

“the Act” means the Road Traffic Act, Chapter 289A.

(2) Words and expressions used in these Regulations and which are also used in the Act shall, unless the context otherwise requires, have the same meaning as assigned to it in the Act.

3. Devices for breath test. A breath test for the purposes of section 62B of the Act shall be carried out using one of the following devices to obtain an indication of the quantity of alcohol in a person’s breath—

- (a) Alco-Sensor VXL RBT manufactured by Intoximeters, Inc., of St. Louis, Missouri;
- (b) Alco-Sensor FST manufactured by Intoximeters, Inc., of St. Louis, Missouri.

4. Conduct of breath test. For the purposes of the breath test for the purposes of section 62B of the Act—

- (a) a person shall provide one specimen of breath for analysis with an Alco-Sensor FST device;
- (b) upon a positive reading from analysis conducted on a specimen by an Alco-Sensor FST device, the person shall provide a specimen of breath for analysis with an Alco-Sensor VXL RBT device; and
- (c) the reading from the specimen under paragraph (b) shall be taken to be the result of the breath test.
