1. Citation. These Regulations may be cited as the

NATIONAL INSURANCE (COLLECTION OF CONTRIBUTIONS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2019,

and shall be read as one with the National Insurance (Collection of Contributions) Regulations, Chapter 205 hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations".

- **2.** Amendment to regulation 4 of principal Regulations. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is amended in subregulation (1) in the chapeau by deleting the words "November 2010" after the words "As of the 1st day of" and substituting therefor the words "January 2020".
- **3.** Amendment to regulation 7 of principal Regulations. Regulation 7 of the principal Regulations is amended in subregulation (1) by deleting the words "November 2010" after the words "As of the 1st day of" and substituting therefor the words "January 2020".
- **4. Amendment to Schedule to principal Regulations.** The Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended as follows—
