A PROCLAMATION



CÉCILE E. F. LA GRENADE Governor-General.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 7 of the Bank Holidays Act (Cap. 25), that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General from time to time by Proclamation in the *Gazette* to appoint a special day or part thereof to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout Grenada;

NOW THEREFORE, I CÉCILE LA GRENADE, Dame Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General in and over Grenada, do appoint Tuesday the 27th day of December, 2016, to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout Grenada;

GIVEN under my hand and the Public Seal of Grenada, this 24th day of November, Two Thousand and Sixteen in the sixty-fifth year of the reign of HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH THE SECOND.
