A PROCLAMATION



CÉCILE E. F. LA GRENADE Governor-General.

WHEREAS by Proclamation dated the 24th day of November, 2016, issued under subsection (1) of section 52 of the Constitution of Grenada, Parliament was prorogued on the 30th day of November, 2016;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 51 of the Constitution of Grenada that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Grenada and shall commence at such time as the Governor-General may by Proclamation appoint;

AND WHEREAS it is further provided by subsection (2) of section 51 of the Constitution of Grenada that there shall be a session of Parliament once at least in every year, so that a period of six months shall not intervene between the last sitting of Parliament in one session and the first sitting in the next session;

NOW THEREFORE, I CÉCILE LA GRENADE, Dame Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General in and over Grenada do hereby appoint the Trade Centre at Morne Rouge, in the parish of Saint George as the place where the Fifth Session of the Ninth Parliament shall be held at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon on Friday the 2nd day of December, 2016, as the time at which the said session shall begin;

AND MEMBERS of the said Parliament and all other Her Majesty's Officers and loving subjects in Grenada, and all others whom it may concern, are hereby required to take due notice hereof and give their ready obedience accordingly.

GIVEN under my hand and the Public Seal of Grenada this 28th day of November, Two Thousand and Sixteen in the sixty-fifth year of the reign of HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH THE SECOND.
