

**ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2021**

**EXPLANATORY NOTES**

This Bill seeks to amend the Road Traffic Act CAP. 289A to provide for specified equipment to be issued to and worn by traffic wardens in the execution of their duties and for incidental matters.

This Bill contains 2 clauses.

**Clause 1** provides for the short title of the Bill.

**Clause 2** provides for amendment to **section 3B** of the principal Act to insert a new subsection (4) which may be amended by the Minister by Order. This new subsection (4) provides for the equipment to be issued to and worn by traffic wardens in the execution of their duties. This clause also provides for amendment to **section 3B** of the principal Act to renumber subsections (4) and (5) as subsections (5) and (6) respectively.

**AN ACT** to amend the Road Traffic Act CAP. 289A.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Queen’s Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives and by the authority of same as follows—

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the

**ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2021,**

and shall be read as one with the Road Traffic Act, Chapter 289A, hereinafter referred to as the “principal Act”.

**Amendment to section 3B of principal Act**

2. Section 3B of the principal Act is amended as follows—

(a) by inserting after subsection (3) the following new subsection—

“(4) The equipment to be issued to and worn in the prescribed manner by a traffic warden in execution of his or her duty shall be—

(a) a two-way communication radio; and

(b) a torch.”;

(b) by renumbering subsection (4) as subsection (5); and

(c) in subsection (5)—

(i) by renumbering subsection (5) as subsection (6); and

(ii) by deleting the words “subsection (2) or (3)” where they appear and substituting therefor the words “subsections (2), (3) and (4)”.
