a) The total number of SEED Beneficiaries before June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2022?

- There are five thousand four hundred and thirteen (5413) households on SEED

b) The number of beneficiaries who were removed from the SEED Program from June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2022, to July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023 and the reasons for the removal of these beneficiaries from the SEED Program?

- A total of one thousand one hundred and six (1106) beneficiaries were suspended from the SEED Program.

- Reasons for removal are as follows:

- ❖ Deceased- Two hundred and seventy-eight (278)
- ❖ Graduated from schools- Five hundred and forty (540)
- ❖ School Drop from school – Eighty-two (82)
- ❖ Migrated- one hundred and twenty (120)
- ❖ Internal Migration – thirty-eight (38)
- ❖ Institutionalized – three (3) or
- ❖ Miscellaneous – forty-five (45)

***(Miscellaneous are beneficiaries that did not comply with recertification, beneficiaries that transfer to elderly home, voluntary removal, uncollected, went to private school etc.)***
