

**RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSES OF SECTION 108 (3) OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, CAP. 289A.**

**WHEREAS** it is provided by Section 108 (2) of the Road Traffic Act, Chapter 289A (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) that the Minister may by regulations amend, vary, suspend or revoke the provisions of the First Schedule;

**WHEREAS** it is further provided by Section 108 (3) of the Act that Regulations made under subsection (2) shall be subject to affirmative resolution;

**WHEREAS** the Minister proposes to amend the First Schedule to the Act to increase the existing annual motor vehicle licence fees by \$50.00 across all vehicle types;

**AND WHEREAS** it is expedient that the Road Traffic (Amendment of First Schedule) Regulations, 2024 which seeks to amend the First Schedule to the Act be approved by the House of Representatives;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that pursuant to section 108 (3) of the Act, the Road Traffic (Amendment of First Schedule) Regulations, 2024 as set out in the Schedule to this Resolution is hereby approved by the House of Representatives.

## **Amendment of First Schedule to the Act**

3. The First Schedule to the Act is amended by repealing Part I and substituting therefor the following new Part—
