PRESIDING JUDGE

Commercial Division of the High Court, Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court

APPOINTING AUTHORITY:

Judicial and Legal Services Commission of the Supreme Court established under the Courts Order 1967 (Imperial Legislation Statutory Instrument No. 223 of 1967) and chaired by the Chief Justice of the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court ("the ECSC").

THE COMMERCIAL DIVISION:

The Commercial Division of the ECSC is a superior court of record which hears and determines Commercial Cases as defined in the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court Civil Procedure Rules 2000 and the Civil Procedure Rules (Revised Edition) 2023. The bulk of the work of the Commercial Division consists of high value cross-border litigation with a base in financial services, international commerce and company and insolvency law. Appeals from decisions of the Commercial Division are heard by the Court of Appeal of the ECSC, from which appeals lie to the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

 To hear and determine all claims commenced in the Commercial Division of the High Court, Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court ('the Commercial Court') including all interim and other applications made in the course of such proceedings. While the bulk of such claims will be commenced and heard in the Commercial Division sitting in Tortola, Territory of the Virgin Islands ('British Virgin Islands'), the Commercial Court Judge may, at the direction of the Chief Justice, hear claims originating from the six Member States and two other UK Overseas Territories which comprise the territorial jurisdiction of the ECSC, whether in Tortola or in the particular Member State or Overseas Territory in question.

- To constitute and convene a Commercial Court Users Committee comprising representatives of local law firms which regularly make use of the facilities of the Commercial Court ('the Committee').
- To keep under review, in conjunction with the Committee, the functioning of the Commercial Court Registry and to make such recommendations as may seem expedient for ensuring the efficient management of cases proceeding in the Commercial Court.





The Consumer Price Index moved from 118.40 index points in the month of June 2023 to 118.34 index points in July 2023, recording a decrease of 0.05%. The table above displays the Index for the months of June 2023, July 2023, and the corresponding months of the last two years: July 2021 and 2022, for comparison.

A decline in the following groupings, resulted in the downward movement of the Index: "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (0.18%), "Health" (0.02%), and "Transport" (0.40%). These decreases are as a result of a drop in the prices of: Electricity (0.82%), the one hundred pound cylinder of Cooking Gas (0.27%), Pharmaceutical Products (0.05%) and Motor Vehicle Fuel (2.29%).

Despite a decline in the overall index, the following groupings recorded increases: "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (0.27%), "Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco" (0.72%), "Furnishing, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance" (0.13%), and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (0.12%). These increases were as a result of a rise in prices of: Breakfast Cereal (0.24%), Other Bakery Products (0.08%), Beef (0.01%), Deli Meat (0.14%), Preserved Fish (1.95%), Cheese (0.17%), Butter (0.03%), Margarine (0.37%), Fresh Fruits (1.04%), Fresh Vegetables (1.77%), Potatoes (1.39%), Sugar (2.16%), Local Honey (0.21%), Other Food Products (0.48%), Soft Drinks and Concentrates (0.73%), Rum (0.03%), Wine (0.88%), Beer (0.45%), Cigarette (1.33%), Glassware (1.18%), Non-durable Household Goods (0.15%), and Personal Care Products (0.28%).

When compared to the corresponding month of last year July 2022, the Index moved from 116.34 index points to 118.34 index points in July 2023, recording an increase of 1.72%. This rise is attributed to increases in the following groupings: "Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages" (7.69%), "Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco" (8.23%), "Clothing and Footwear" (1.50%), "Furnishing, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance" (2.16%), "Health" (1.41%), "Recreation and Culture" (0.70%), "Education" (1.78%), "Restaurants and Hotels" (10.18%) and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (4.59%). These increases resulted from rising prices of: Rice (2.12%), Breakfast Cereals and Flour (3.60%), Other Bakery Products (6.28%), Pasta Products (7.09%), Beef (1.51%), Pork (8.00%), Mutton (0.83%), Poultry (4.31%), Deli Meats (2.53%), Fresh Fish (19.16%), Preserved Fish (10.42%), Milk (5.93%), Cheese (4.94%), Butter (12.38%), Margarine (8.04%), Cooking Oil (5.40%), Fresh Fruits (3.41%), Preserved Fruits (0.53%), Fresh Vegetables (11.30%), Potatoes (8.63%), Frozen Vegetables (4.29%), Sugar (33.26%), Jams and Honey (2.15%), Ice Cream (6.74%), Other Food Products (9.05%), Coffee, Tea and Cocca Products (10.77%), Mineral Water (1.92%), Soft Drinks and Concentrates (5.99%), Fruit Juices (4.27%), Rum (2.93%), Wine (11.28%), Beer (8.06%), Cigarettes (10.48%), Clothing Materials (6.98%), Men's Clothing (4.16%), Children's and Infant's Clothing (6.03%), Other Clothing Accessories (9.83%), Glassware (3.37%), Small Tools (2.48%), Non-durable Household Goods (4.81%), Medical Services (8.32%), Books (4.11%), Pre-primary and Primary Education (3.12%), Tertiary Education (1.16%), Restaurant Services (10.18%), Personal Care Products (3.89%), Care for the Elderly (36.67%) and Funeral Services (20.55%).

On the other hand, "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" and "Transport" declined by (0.84%) and (1.52%) respectively, due to decrease in the price of Electricity (3.87%), the one hundred pound cylinder of Cooking Gas (15.67%) and Passenger Transport Service by Air (13.16%). All other groupings remained comparatively constant.

Consequently, the first ation rate for July 2023 is 1.72%, compared to a rate of 3.24% recorded in July 2022.
