BE IT ENACTED by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives and by the authority of the same as follows—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the

BANK HOLIDAYS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2025,

and shall be read as one with the Bank Holidays Act, Chapter 25 hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act".

Amendment of Schedule to principal Act

2. The Schedule to the principal Act is amended by deleting the following—

"The first Monday in August which shall be known and referred to as Emancipation Holiday."

and substituting therefor the following—

"The first day in August which shall be known and referred to as Emancipation Day.".
