### REPORT TO GRENADA HOUSES OF PARLIAMENT FOR THE REPORTING PERIOD 1st JULY 2024 TO 31ST DECEMBER 2024

#### **NOTE**

#### THIS IS NOT A FINANCIAL REPORT.

The information contained in this report is in accordance with the provisions of Section 15 of the Grenada Citizenship by Investment Act 15 of 2013.

#### Section 15.

- (1) The Minister shall, every six months on the prescribed dates, prepare a report containing the prescribed information on the applications made, granted and refused under the Act, and shall, as soon as practicable but not later than thirty days after the completion of the report, cause a copy of the report to be laid before the House of Representatives.
- (2) The reports referred to in sub-section (1) shall set out information as prescribed in sub-section (3) for the six-month period in each year starting on January 1, and July 1 and may be prepared within one month of the expiry of each half-yearly period.
- (3) The information contained in the reports referred to in sub-section (2) shall include-
  - (a) the number of applications made, granted and refused under the Act;
  - (b) the amounts of the investments, as the case may be;
  - (c) the names of the approved project, government-sponsored project in respect of which payment was made;
  - (d) the aggregate amounts in the National Transformation Fund, at the date of the report;
  - (e) the aggregate amounts of funds received pursuant to section (11) of this Act; and
  - (f) such other information as the Minister may consider appropriate.





**Note**: The Number of Citizenship Certificates issued depends on the number of approvals received within the period. For example, files submitted in 2023 but approved in 2024 will be recorded as approvals for 2024. Also note that the significant increase in citizenship issued reflects processing efficiencies employed by the Agency during the period, and large numbers of applications in backlog, received during January to March 2023 resulting from the Russian/Ukraine War.

**Note:** There continued to be significant reduction in the Number of Applications received during this period due to the March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023, deadline for the acceptance of Russian & Belarusian applications. Figure 2: Distribution of Number Investors per Project – 1st July 2024 to 31st December 2024







Figure 3: Total Amount Invested per Active Project – 1<sup>st</sup> July 2024 – December 31<sup>st</sup> 2024 vs. 1<sup>st</sup> July 2023 – December 31<sup>st</sup> 2023

Figure 4: Distribution of Total Investment and Revenues USD-1st July 2024 to 31st December 2024





Figure 5: Year-on-Year Comparison of Total Investment and Revenues (USD) – 1st July 2024 to 31st December 2024
