#### CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (JAN 2010 = 100)

#### APRIL 2025

The CPI is compiled at two levels. The first level uses an equally-weighted geometric mean (Jevons) index in which the price relative is derived as a geometric average of 198 items, containing 1102 varieties obtained from 193 outlets.

In the second level, the weights are applied to derive the weighted geometric aggregate (Cobb-Douglas) index. The weights represent the pattern of consumers' expenditure for Grenada, derived from the Household Income and Expenditure Survey conducted over the period October 2007 – February 2008.

The above table shows the Consumer Price Index for the months of April 2025, March 2025, and the corresponding months of the last two years: April 2024, and April 2023, for comparison. The overall index moved from 120.52 index points in March 2025 to 120.70 index points in April 2025 representing an increase of 0.15%. An examination of the various groups shows the following:

Price increases were recorded in the groupings as follows: "Alcohol Beverages and Tobacco", (0.06%), "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (0.34%), "Health" (0.16%), "Transport" (0.32%), and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (0.02%), resulting from price increases of the following items: Beer (0.01%), Cigarette (0.14%), Materials for the Repair of Dwelling (0.13%), Electricity (0.72%), One Hundred Pound Cylinder of Cooking Gas (3.08%), Pharmaceutical Products (0.35%), Motor Vehicle Fuel (1.86%), and Personal Care Products (0.04%).

Despite the overall increase in the index, the groupings "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages", and "Furnishing, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance", recorded a decrease of 0.06%, and 0.03%, respectively due to a drop in the price of: Fresh Fish (0.58%), Milk (17.43%), Fresh Vegetables (3.51%), Potatoes (1.53%), Jams and Honey (0.14%), Small Tools (0.27%), and Non-durable Household Goods (0.05%).

The other groupings remained relatively constant.

When compared to the corresponding month of last year, April 2024, the index moved from 120.08 index points to 120.70 index points in April 2025, recording an increase of 0.51%. This rise is attributed to increases in the following groupings: "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (1.27%), "Alcohol Beverages and Tobacco" (1.30%), "Clothing and Footwear" (1.61%), "Furnishing, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance" (0.32%), "Health" (1.60%), "Transport" (1.21%), "Communication" (0.13%), "Recreation and Culture" (0.04%), "Education" (1.26%), and "Restaurant and Hotels" (6.85%). These increases resulted from a rise in the following items: Rice (10.01%), Cereals and Other Products (0.64%), Bread (0.06%), Beef (3.69%), Pork (1.57%), Mutton (6.60%), Poultry (1.16%), Deli Meats (0.82%), Fresh Fish (0.08%), Preserved Fish (0.30%), Milk (0.75%), Cheese (0.80%), Eggs (1.62%), Butter (2.54%), Margarine (4.04%), Fresh Fruits (16.14%), Preserved Fruits (1.07%), Potatoes (3.80%), Frozen Vegetables (2.22%), Sugar (0.02%), Jams and Honey (2.29%), Other Food Products (1.46%), Coffee, Tea and Cocoa Products (0.62%), Water (5.22%), Soft Drinks (2.10%), Fruit Juices (3.25%), Rum (1.15%), Wine (0.96%), Beer (1.06%), Cigarettes (1.79%), Men's Clothing (0.92%), Children and Infants Clothing (3.28%), Clothing Accessories (2.79%), Men's Footwear (2.29%), Women's Footwear (3.87%), Glassware (0.44%), Major Tools (1.32%), Small Tools (4.52%), Non-durable Household Goods (0.70%), Pharmaceutical Products (0.84%), Medical Services (4.20%), Passenger Transport Services by Air (29.91%), Telephone Services (0.14%), Books (0.26%), Pre-Primary and Primary Education (4.03%), and Restaurant Services (6.85%).

On the other hand, "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" declined by (0.38%), and (2.82%) respectively due to price decreases of Materials for the Repair of Dwelling (1.09%), Electricity (2.19%), One Hundred Pound Cylinder of Cooking Gas (4,24%), and Personal Care Products (7.18%).

Consequently, the inflation rate for April 2025 is 0.51% compared to a rate of 1.54% in April 2024.
