AN ACT to authorise the Minister of Finance to borrow from various sources, the amount of Four Hundred and Fifty Million Eastern Caribbean Dollars (EC\$450,000,000.00) for the purpose of financing the 2026 Budget.

BE IT ENACTED by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the

Short title.

2026 BUDGET LOAN AUTHORISATION ACT, 2025.

2.—(1) The Minister of Finance is hereby authorised to raise a loan in the amount of Four Hundred and Fifty Million Eastern Caribbean Dollars (EC\$450,000,000.00) for the purpose of financing the 2026 Budget.

(2) All monies borrowed under this Act shall be effected and secured pursuant to the terms and conditions specified in the Schedule.
