A PROCLAMATION



CÉCILE ELLEN FLEURETTE LA GRENADE  
*Governor-General.*

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 7 of the Bank Holidays Act Cap. 25, that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General from time to time by Proclamation in the *Gazette* to appoint a special day or part thereof to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout Grenada;

NOW THEREFORE, I CÉCILE ELLEN FLEURETTE LA GRENADE, Dame Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General in and over Grenada, hereby appoint Monday 16th February, 2026, and from 12 noon on Tuesday 17th February, 2026, to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout Carriacou and Petit Martinique;

GIVEN under my hand and the Public Seal of Grenada, this 11th day of February Two Thousand and Twenty-Six in the fourth year of the reign of HIS MAJESTY KING CHARLES THE THIRD.
