A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 10 of the National Honours and Awards Act, Chapter 204A that, each year on Independence Day or at such other times as may be expedient, it shall be lawful for the Governor-General, acting on the advice of the Prime Minister on the recommendation of the National Awards Advisory Committee, to confer awards on persons, living or dead who have rendered distinguished and meritorious service to the nation of Grenada or who are otherwise deemed worthy of such awards;

WHEREAS the nation of Grenada is celebrating 52 years of independence on 7th February 2026;

AND WHEREAS the National Awards Advisory Committee has submitted a recommendation to the Prime Minister, and the Prime Minister has advised the Governor-General that eleven (11) persons be awarded for distinguished and meritorious service to the nation of Grenada;

NOW THEREFORE, I, CÉCILE ELLEN FLEURETTE LA GRENADE, Dame Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General in and over Grenada, am graciously pleased to approve awards with effect from 7th February 2026, Independence Day, to the under-mentioned:
