Message from the Senate to the House of Representatives

The Senate at its meeting on April 8, 2026 passed the Possessory Titles (Amendment) Bill, 2026 with an amendment. The following amendment was made to which they desire the concurrence of the House of Representatives:

Possessory Titles (Amendment) Bill, 2026

Clause 19 to be deleted "**Clause 19** seeks to repeal subsections (1) and (2) of section 34 of the principal Act to remove the provisions relating to fixed fees for services by attorneys-at-law provided under the Possessory Titles Act, 2016." Therefore, there would now be 21 clauses instead of 22.
