STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS NO. 10 OF 2026

THE AUTHORITY, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER, IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED PURSUANT TO SECTION 75 (1) OF THE PORTS AUTHORITY ACT, CHAPTER 247 OF THE CONTINUOUS REVISED EDITION OF THE LAWS OF GRENADA MAKES THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS—

(Gazetted 3rd July, 2026).

1. Citation. These Regulations may be cited as the

PORTS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2026,

and shall be read as one with the Ports Regulations, Chapter 247 hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”.

2. Amendment of Schedule to principal Regulations. The Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended in Part V by inserting immediately after regulation 17 the following new regulation—

“18. TUG SERVICES

- A) The Authority may provide tug services for the berthing, unberthing, shifting, towing or manoeuvring of vessels within the ports of Grenada and may impose charges in respect of such services.
- B) Tug services may be compulsory where required by the Authority having regard to—
 - (i) the gross tonnage of the vessel;
 - (ii) the nature of the cargo carried;
 - (iii) navigational safety;
 - (iv) weather or sea conditions; or
 - (v) any other operational or safety consideration determined by the Authority.
- C) The charges in respect of tug services shall be calculated per tug move and are as follows—

- D) A fuel surcharge shall be added to the rates specified above on a *pro rata* basis where the price of diesel exceeds fourteen dollars in Eastern Caribbean currency.
- E) For the purposes of this regulation, “tug move” includes any berthing, unberthing, shifting, towing or repositioning operation carried out by a tug vessel.”.
