**RESOLUTION FOR THE SUPPLEMENTARY ESTIMATES OF EXPENDITURE
FOR 2026**

WHEREAS it is necessary to provide for the services of the State of Grenada for the Year 2026 by means of an Appropriation Act;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Supplementary Estimates of Expenditure for 2026 be approved.

(b) By the Leader of Government's Business:

**RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSES OF SECTION 107 (2) OF THE
REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ACT CAP. 286A**

WHEREAS it is provided by section 107 (1) of the Representation of the People Act Cap. 286A (hereinafter referred to as "**the Act**") that the Governor-General may make Regulations generally for giving effect to the provisions of the Act;

WHEREAS section 107 (1) (c) provides that the Governor-General may make Regulations prescribing the symbols to be used on every ballot paper, and the mode of allocation of such symbols to candidates;

WHEREAS section 107 (2) provides that Regulations made under the Act are subject to affirmative resolution;

WHEREAS regulations have been made to insert a new symbol to be used on ballot papers under the Representation of the People (Election Symbols) Regulations Cap. 286A;

AND WHEREAS it is now expedient that the Representation of the People (Election Symbols) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 2026 attached hereto as a Schedule be approved by the House of Representatives;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that pursuant to section 107 (2) of the Act, the Representation of the People (Election Symbols) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 2026 be now approved.

Message from the Senate to the House of Representatives

The Senate at its meeting on July 31, 2026 passed the Citizenship By Investment (Amendment) Bill, 2026. The following amendments were made to which they desire the concurrence of the House of Representatives:

GRENADA CITIZENSHIP BY INVESTMENT (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2026

Sections 13H and section 15B (1) are exactly the same. The Senate removed section 13H.

Therefore, in the

ARRANGEMENT OF CLAUSES

Clause 11 should now read:

“Insertion of new sections 13A to 13G”, instead of “13A to 13H”.

In the text of the bill itself, Clause 11 should now read:

“Insertion of new sections 13A to 13G in the principal Act

11. The principal Act is amended by inserting immediately after section 13 the following and new sections 13A, 13B, 13C, 13D, 13E, 13F and 13G.”

Consequently, the entire section 13H as it appears in the bill, **“Disclosure of Information”** should be deleted.
